



This time of the year winter rains pour down on the island, leaving streams and large puddles of water underneath tents that have not yet been provided tarps or

The rain pours into the tents from above due to lack of tarps, and water runs on the floor because of having no pallets to keep the tent high and dry.

The majority of the refugees are in this predicament: with only a tent to sleep in and no pallets underneath or tarp above to keep the water from running in and bringing in cold and sickness to their little ones.

You can help these families and their little ones in their time of need. - For \$5.50 you can bless someone with a pallet.

- A gift of \$17 will give someone 100 diapers.
- \$33 will provide a family with two tarps. For \$55 you can bless a family of four with a tent, tarps, and pallets.





Did you know that a refugee will stand an average of six hours a day in line? Six hours that you can choose to spend on the job, clean your house, go shopping, or prepare your own meal.




The December and January teams are now full!



















Announcing the event location! The Spring Smash Event will be held at 73 Orchard Rd., Bird In Hand, PA 17505

That is the question people of Moria ask when they see a volunteer standing outside for hours on end checking peoples I.D. to make sure they are allowed in that specific section of camp. Just this week we heard the story of a lady who went to church simply because she wanted to know why people would travel across the world to do this simple job in uncomfortable conditions. What an opportunity to share the Gospel to someone who likely had never heard it! IS8 volunteers are working in the cold and rain this time of year. Their commitment to serve people despite the weather and their personal comfort speaks volumes to the refugees in camp. 





