
Much love and warmest wishes to our ground team who are spending this special time of year looking after the displaced families.

May this Christmas be the merriest one for you.





As dental care providers for the vulnerable population it is essential we focus not just on treatment but also on prevention. It is unfortunate that in the camps the diet is high in sugar content to keep up energy levels and smoking is high in prevalence in face of the adversity and stress levels the population is facing. Dental education is, therefore, vital to prevent tooth decay, pain, and the eventual extractions and loss of teeth.

Dear supporters, volunteers, and well wishers

We have been monitoring the ground and political situation on an international level, as well as the inside of Moria camp over the last few weeks to months. It feels as though, the opportunity to provide care to our refugee friends in Moria, has come to a natural end for Health Point.

We are not sad, we are proud.

This has been a success, a story of resilience, love, unity and humanity. Without a doubt, every single one of you who has been a part of this exhilarating journey has shown together, we can construct all those elements which will make this world a more tolerant place. There is hope.

We are so proud of The Health Point Foundation in Lesvos. From a basic marquee, with the help of Lesvos Winterproof and BDFM, it transformed into an amazing field hospital, staffed by incredibly dedicated and skilled staff from all over the world. Professional colleagues from other medical NGOs were openly envious of our facilities when they visited and admired our work. Our patients enjoyed the best of medical and personal care 24 hours a day, something world renown medical organisations could not provide here in Moria. Health Point has become an ethos. A vision. And you all contributed to this.

Why this decision?

With the EU Turkey deal taking effect, we no longer have access to refugees needing help. We have kept the medical tent open 24 hours a day in the recent unsettled times and have seen just a few patients. We have also sought every way possible to offer our services to those held in Moria detention centre without success. It no longer makes sense for us to stay here. We have exhausted this

We have a future cadre volunteers who are self-funding and sacrificing their time to help refugees and in order to make the best of their commitment we need to move to where there are needs that we can address. Immediately, this means we are attempting to focus our work in Idomeni. And also aiming to support Better Days where they chose to settle.

If you were planning to come to Lesvos in the near future, we are sorry for the inconvenience this causes but please contact us if you are interested in changing your travel plans to Idomeni. Alternately, most of you may be able to terminate your journey at Athens and seek to offer services there via other NGOs.

Lastly, your support, donations, efforts, love, and wishes have gone a very long way. We would like to thank every single one of you for your time and energy, from the bottom of ours but also our refugee friends hearts. They received all your love. We luckily, were the vessels for this extra ordinary exchange.
