Summary of the Case: On Saturday the 20th of April 2019 at 4.20am CEST the Alarm phone shift team was alerted to a boat in distress carrying 29 people (including 12 children and 7 women). At 4.33am we contacted the Greek coast guard and gave them the position of the boat. At 4:55am the people from the boat could see the coast guard, $\,$ and the coast guard confirmed the rescue to Lesvos at 5:24am. At 5:39am the travellers also confirmed rescue, and sent their location from land.
